Mantais Economaidd:

Am ragor o wybodaeth:


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Mae modd mynd i lefydd ar un olwyn. (iaith)

“Without my Welsh education in School I would not have had all the opportunities to present and perform and I would not have been encouraged to start as a referee at 16 years old. I carry Welsh with me wherever I referee in the world. Before each game I listen to Welsh music. I'm lucky enough to have two languages and Welsh is an important part of who I am.”



What are the advantages of two languages?

Economic advantages:

Bilingual people in Wales earn more on average in comparison with people who speak one language.

Educational benefits:

Academic research has confirmed that bilingual children can think more creatively and flexibly and tend to score higher in IQ tests than those who speak one language.

65% of Europeans speak at least two languages

It is easier for those who speak two languages to learn other languages

More jobs than ever before in Wales are asking for bilingual skills. Welsh is a valuable asset in the workplace

Over two thirds of the world's population speak two or more languages!

Research also determines that bilingual pupils also tend to do better in other subjects at school

On average, bilingual children achieve higher English test and exam results than children who speak only one language

Cognitive Skills:

Bilingualism strengthens the cognitive muscles – bilinguals tend to be more creative, flexible and sensitive. They seem to think more freely and more elaborately, whilst also finding it easier to focus on a range of tasks simultaneously.
